Mechanically Performing Cufflink Collections by Roland Iten

If you have ever struggled to mount a set of cufflinks onto your crisply starched cuffs, or wished they fit a little tighter, (or looser), or perhaps would even welcome the opportunity to regulate the circumference of your cuff so that it can be worn under or over your watch depending on the occasion, and finally, if you ever wished your cufflinks could morph from daytime elegance to night time dazzle with just one flip or click, then the Roland Iten Mechanically Performing Cufflink Collections are for you.

Take the RC81 models for instance. By rotating the diamond studded lever, which can be worn flipped to one side for a concealed, sober day-time look, or flipped to other side to reveal a 20 TW VVS1 diamond studded (40 per set), night time extravaganza, an optimal force translation results in sixteen pirouetting parts in the internal "gearbox" (that's right, these cufflinks have a gearbox), to turn and lock the link into your cuff, affording you the tightest fit of any cufflink available today. Excellent for those occasions when you simply can't afford for your cuff to pear out from under your jacket.
